1st hour: (Sarbjit Singh)

2. Which Granth is this shabad written in?
3. **In your own words** describe the meaning of each of the 4 lines in the shabad
4. According to the shabad what is does Guru ji telling us to avoid?
5. According to the shabad how can one become true Khalsa?
6. Write 5 Baanis in Dasam Granth and briefly explain what they are about?

Bonus Question—answer any one of the two

(10 points):

1. The shabad describes some rituals that the Khalsa should not follow. Briefly describe some rituals that you or your family may have or currently practice. How do those rituals align with this shabad?

2. If you or your family does not follow any rituals, do you notice any rituals followed at your local Gurduara? How do those align with this shabad?

2nd hour: (Arvind Singh)

1. Ardas research: Look up and write word meanings (in English) and sentence translations (in English) for Sections 1-6 of Ardas in your workbooks.
