Panjabi Class Homework

Panjabi:

1. Read the story on page 110-111 (Kabul de Sangat) of the book and then complete the hand out given in class (see the attachment for your reference or you can print a new sheet if you need one). This story has been read in the class and student should be able to tell meaning of the story. The objective of doing it again at home is to reinforce the reading. Reading should be done under the supervision of parent(s) or older adult.
2. Write the Shabad (In fact this is a Vaar written by Bhai Gurdas Ji) given at the end of the story (Kabul de Sangat). The objective of writing this is to familiarize the kids with Gurbani other than nitnem.

In the Story Kabul de Sangat, Guru Arjan Sahib ji found out about the sangat coming to meet him from far away. He was pleased with their dedication and affection. Guru Sahib practiced what he preached and showed his love for his sangat by setting up a resting area where Guru Sahib himself went and served the sangat. The theme being that if a Sikh of the Guru makes an honest effort to meet and follow the Guru, the Guru himself will come to greet and serve the Sikh. Bhai Gurdas ji explains this important concept in his Vaar as follows:

ਚਰਨ ਸਰਨਿ ਗੁਰ ਏਕ ਪੈਡਾ ਜਾਇ ਚਲ
ਸਤਿ ਗੁਰ ਕੋਟਿ ਪੈਡਾ ਆਗੇ ਹੋਇ ਲੇਤ ਹੈ ॥
ਏਕ ਬਾਰ ਸਤਿਗੁਰ ਮੰਤ੍ਰ ਸਿਮਰਨ ਮਾਤ੍ਰ
ਸਿਮਰਨ ਤਾਹਿ ਬਾਰੰਬਾਰ ਗੁਰ ਹੇਤ ਹੈ ॥
ਭਾਵਨੀ ਭਗਤਿ ਭਾਇ ਕਉਡੀ ਅਗ੍ਭਾਗਿ ਰਾਖੈ
ਤਾਹਿ ਗੁਰ ਸਰਬ ਨਿਧਾਨ ਦਾਨ ਦੇਤ ਹੈ ॥
ਸਤਿਗੁਰ ਦਇਆ ਨਿਧਿ ਮਹਿਮਾ ਅਗਾਧਿ ਬੋਧਿ
ਨਮੋ ਨਮੋ ਨਮੋ ਨਮੋ ਨੇਤ ਨੇਤ ਨੇਤ ਹੈ ॥੧੧॥
