Important Note to the Parents:

Group A: Final exam will be on May 16th (oral & written)

Oral Section: (Final Exam on May 16th)

1. proper pronunciation of ਓ – ਏ,
2. Proper pronunciation of numbers ੧-੧੦,
3. All Guru's name in order (1st Guru – present Guru)
4. **Japuji Sahib:** Mool Mantar, first and second Pauris.

Written Portion: (Final Exam on May 16th)

1. know how to write (ਓ – ਏ) with English letter sounds
2. Know how to write Punjabi numbers ੧-੧੦
3. Recognize images from your text book and know their first Punjabi letter and English sounds
4. Matching Punjabi letter sounds to beginning word sounds and/or images from the text book.
5. Matching English sounds (ਓ -ਏ) to Punjabi letters and /or images from the book.

Important Note to the Parents:

Group B: Oral Exam is on May 9th & Written Exam is on May 16th

On Saturday, kids took their pre- test for written portion of the final exam. Please check their graded test and have them practice on where they show mistakes. We also had a review of the oral portion of the exam. In order to go the next grade, kids will need to score at least 78% in both portions of the final test. Please make sure your child is not absent during the test dates.

Oral Section: (Final Exam next week May 9th)

- Proper pronunciation of ਓ – ਏ
- Proper pronunciation of numbers ੧- ੧੦ and random #s will be asked in English (need to know in Punjabi)
- Japuji Sahib: 1-5 pauries
- History questions 1-15
- Questions from the following sakhis:
 - Sacha Sauda on page 55
 - Gwalior De Kile to Rihaee on pg 58
 - Vaisakhi – ੧੬੯੯ on page 59
- Sakhi uestion will include place names only (not dates), main characters and major event

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Written Section: (Final Exam on May 16th)

- Know how to write ਓ - ਫ਼ with English sounds (as taught in the class)
- Know what comes before & after each letter (see the examples in pre-test)
- Know all **English sounds** (practice from the sheet provided in the class and see the examples in the pre-test – Punjabi to English / English to Punjabi)
- Be able to recognize pictures from your textbook to match Punjabi letters and English sounds
- **Mukta words** (practice from the sheet provided, English meanings will be provided)
- Know how to write Punjabi number ੧-੧੦
- Matching Guru's name to the correct #s
- Matching Panj Piayaras & Char Sahibzadas names with correct #s
- Bonus Point – an extra sakhi question, your name written in Punjabi, additional pauri of Japuji Sahib.
