- I. List the rules 9-10 of Gurbani Grammar (Aunkar and Sihari)**
- II. For each rule, provide 1 example from Gurbani.**
- III. In each example, identify the Noun and Adjective**
- IV. For each Noun and Adjective, explain why or why not an Aunkar or Sihari is used**
- V. For the Shabad “ਹਸਤ ਖੇਲਤ ਤੇਰੇ ਦੇਹੁਰੇ ਆਇਆ” that was reviewed in class, list at least 5 words and describe how rules 1-10 might be applied to those words**

## **2<sup>nd</sup> hour: (Arvind Singh)**
