Dear parents,

All of the students performed well on their evaluation test. We are proud of them. Next week, they will receive their curriculum for second grade.

We are all familiar with benefits of reading for a child. This applies to Punjabi also. Please spend as much time as you can listening to your child read out loud in Punjabi. This will help with spelling, enunciation, sentence structure, vocabulary, grammar and fluency. Under the Punjabi class tab on our website, there is a link for a reading program. If you haven't already, start with reading Level 1.

Here is a summary of what we learned in class.

1. Definition of shabd (Word) in Punjabi. They wrote the definition in their notebooks. On exams, they will be required to write the definition in Punjabi.
2. What is a noun? We learned the definition in English and Punjabi. On exams, they will be required to write the definition in Punjabi.
3. We discussed many examples of nouns in Punjabi and English. Each student did a great job coming up with their own examples of a noun.
4. We reviewed days of the week in Punjabi.
5. In first grade, the students learned history questions from 1 to 53. We started to discuss questions 54-60.

In second grade, students will write down the answer to history questions on quizzes and exams. They will not be tested orally. To familiarize them with spelling, it's a good idea to have your child read the history questions to you. Spelling mistakes don't count on the test, but the answer should be close enough so grader knows that you have the right answer.
